

## UK Tax Efficient Giving

Donations by UK taxpayers to The Diocesan College Trust are eligible for tax relief.

If you are a UK tax payer, we can receive 25p for every £1 you donate. That means that your £100 donation is worth £125 to the Trust, or around R900.

In addition, if you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.

This is because the UK government's Gift Aid scheme allows us to reclaim tax on donations. For your donation(s) to be eligible for Gift-Aid you must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax for each tax year (6 April one year to 5 April the next) that is at least equal to the tax that the Trust reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year.
