

ALL ROUNDERS TIE POINTS ARRANGEMENTS: February 2014

The All-rounders Tie will be awarded when you have achieved the subminimum of 24 points for each of the three areas (Academic, Sport, and Service and Society), with a combined subminimum of 75 points together.

All-rounders Academic Tie points

Points can be scored in two areas: up to a maximum of 6 points in a year for exam marks performances, and up to 5 points a year for Industry report ratings.

Mid-year and end of year performances:

Two opportunities to earn: (Maximum 6 per year)

Average of 70% (or 3 subjects above 75%) or higher at either midyear or end of year reports (Grade 10 and 12 – Sept Reports) 3 all-rounders tie points

Average of 60% (or 3 subjects above 65%) or higher at either midyear or end of year reports (Grade 10 and 12 – Sept Reports) 2 all-rounders tie points

Average of 50% (or 3 subjects above 55%) or higher at either midyear or end of year reports (Grade 10 and 12 – Sept Reports) 1 all-rounders tie points

Industry Reports:

Two opportunities to earn: Industry ratings according to table below (Maximum 5 points per year)

You can earn points following industry Reports at the following opportunities:

All-rounders Sports Points

Points can be scored for taking part in games at certain levels as indicated below:

The maximum award for participation per sport for one season is 3 points.

Awarded Colours for a Sport.....	3 points
If a boy plays 80% of matches for an A or B team in a season.....	3 points
If a boy plays 80% of matches for a C team in a season.....	2 points
If a boy plays 80% of matches for a D in a season.....	1 point
Athletics - school squad for Triangular.....	3 points
- finalist on Sports Day / finalist in WP trials etc (max 3).....	1 point
House matches (per season).....	1 points
Being Captain of a Sports Team.....	1 point

You can also be awarded points for Enthusiasm and/or sportsmanship by your coach. This is at the coach's discretion and under coach's signature, and the maximum per season is:..... 3 points

All-Rounders Service and Society points

The maximum for one 'activity' (indicated by the brackets) is 6 points per year.

Performing as a soloist in a School Concert (max 6 points per year)	2 points
Participating in a recognised, weekly school ensemble	3 points
Full year's lessons in an instrument (max 6 points per year)	3 points
Finalist in the Bishops Eisteddfod (max 3 points per year).....	1 point
Active and full member / participant in Society for year.....	2 points
Secretary / President of Society.....	1 point
Member of SRF (end of year).....	2 points
Member of Interact committee (end of year)	2 points
Acting in School play (Main / support)	4 / 2 points
Acting in House play (Main / support).....	2 / 1 points
Backstage in School play	2 points
AV crew (full year and at the descretion of the MiC AV)	1 - 4 points
Library Monitor (full year).....	2 point 2
Scorer for a season.....	2 points

Presidents Award (Bronze = 1 / Silver = 2 / Gold = 3).....	1 - 3 points
Leadership award (Pass = 1 / Merit = 2 / Distinction = 3).....	1 -3 points
